As more and more discussion is focused on Islam, it is the desire of TACHERIA to witness to the importance of an open interfaith dialogue. Jamal Rahman is a Sufi Muslim and an interfaith minister in Seattle, Washington who brings a unique perspective that we need to hear. Jamal's passion lies in interfaith community building. He remains rooted in his Islamic tradition and cultivates a "spaciousness" by being open to the beauty and wisdom of other faiths. By authentically and appreciatively understanding other paths, Jamal feels that he becomes a better Muslim. This spaciousness is not about conversion but about completion. Since 9/11 Jamal has been collaborating with Rabbi Ted Falcon and Pastor Don Mackenzie (the Three Amigos) in presenting a message of spiritual inclusivity.

Jamal is the author of many books, including, *Spiritual Gems of Islam* (2013); *Sacred Laughter of the Sufis* (2014); and with Rabbi Falcon and Rev. Mackenzie, *Getting to the Heart of Interfaith* (2009) and *Finding Peace Through Spiritual Practice* (Release December, 2015).
